

The PDD program works with others to support adults with developmental disabilities to be included in community life and to be as independent as possible.

Completion of this form is the first step in the process of applying to the PDD program.

To apply to the Persons with Developmental Disabilities (PDD) program you must be the individual who will be receiving services, their supporter, co-decision maker, or legally appointed guardian as defined in the *Adult Guardianship or Trusteeship Act*.

To be eligible for the PDD program the Individual must meet the following criteria:

- Be at least 18 years old when services commence
- Have a developmental disability that includes the following
 - Significant limitation in intellectual capacity (an IQ of 70 or lower); and,
 - Significant limitations in adaptive skills
- Have acquired the developmental disability before turning 18 years old
- Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident as defined by the Canadian *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act*
- Live and plan to receive services in Alberta
- Must not live in a facility or institution under the jurisdiction of another legislative authority

The personal information you provide is being collected to determine eligibility for different social-based programs, benefits or services offered by the Government of Alberta under Alberta Supports. If you choose to apply, the personal information you provide will be used and disclosed in the application process, for ongoing eligibility verification, and for delivery of those programs, benefits or services once eligibility is confirmed.

The personal information provided to Alberta Supports is collected, used and disclosed under the authority of sections 33-40 of the *Freedom of information and Protection of Privacy Act* and various statutes establishing the programs included in Alberta Supports.
